Traffic Pattern Changes at Exit 30 in Davidson on the I-77 Southbound Off-Ramp and the I-77 Northbound On-Ramp

Charlotte, N.C. (September 15, 2017) — Crews are preparing a slight traffic shift on two ramps on I-77 at Exit 30 in Davidson as construction continues on the new Griffith Street bridge. Tonight, the I-77 southbound Exit 30 off-ramp will close overnight from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. as crews shift traffic to the west. Traffic travelling southbound on I-77 will proceed to Exit 28, then take I-77 northbound to Exit 30.

At the end of September, the I-77 northbound on-ramp at Exit 30 will experience a permanent slight traffic shift to the east. Motorists travelling eastbound on Griffith Street towards Davidson will no longer be able to turn left on the eastside of the bridge. Motorists must continue east towards Davidson and use the roundabout to take I-77 northbound.

*Traffic shifts are subject to weather conditions and major special events in the region.

Motorists are encouraged to pay attention when approaching the work zone, obey the posted speed limit and work zone signs, and allow extra time to reach their destinations safely.

Once the project is complete, dedicated express lanes will run adjacent to the existing general purpose lanes. The number of general purpose lanes will remain the same as today. Drivers will have the choice of using the express lanes to avoid travel delays, the general purpose lanes or a combination of both. Vehicles with three or more occupants (including the driver) and equipped with a transponder may use the express lanes for free. The full 26-mile project is slated to be completed in 2018.
